

1. The tournament will begin May 26th, 2018 and end Aug 19, 2018.
2. The tournament will be open to participating teams of two bowlers each. Teams may consist of 2 men, 2 women, or 1 man and 1 woman. Also 1 Junior and any adult. All bowlers must be current USBC members. Previous year Junior USBC members may refer to their final Junior USBC averages, providing that they possess an Adult USBC card for the current year. Non USBC members may participate in the tournament by virtue of purchasing a USBC membership.
3. The tournament will consist of three separate divisions based upon combined team averages as follows:
  - Division "AA"** Team Average: 400 and above
  - Division "BB"** Team Average: 399 and below
  - Adult – "JR"** Team Average: Any
4. Team handicaps for each division of the tournament will be as follows:
  - Division "AA"** 90% of the difference between the participating doubles team average and 460
  - Division "BB"**: 90% of the difference between the participating doubles team average and 400
  - Division "Adult JR"**: 90% of the difference between the participating doubles team average and 420
5. Entries for the tournament will be accepted until the start of the final squad of the tournament or until such time as all remaining squads have filled to capacity.
6. Entry fee for each Doubles team participating in the tournament will be \$80.00 which shall be distributed as follows: \$30.00 bowling, \$45.00 prize fund and \$5.00 expenses. Adult-JR \$30 for bowling, \$10 single entry for adult, \$5 expense, \$35 for Junior Scholarship fund!
7. Entry fees must accompany each Team entry into the tournament. Entry fees shall be non-refundable. Checks for entry fees should be made out to "Wilsonville Lanes". All returned checks will be assessed a \$25.00 service charge and if not paid by Aug 19<sup>h</sup> 2018, all scores will be disqualified.
8. Reserved squad times may only be revised or canceled with adequate notice given at the discretion of Wilsonville Lanes and depending upon the remaining space available.
9. Averages: Each entrant into the tournament will use their highest USBC sanctioned average based on a minimum of 21 games or more of the 2017-2018 bowling season (excluding summer 2017). If entrant has no such league average for the 2017-2018 season, entrant shall instead use their highest 2016-2017, if none we will go back up to 3 years (2014-2015). A bowler's average is subject to re-rating at the tournament directors' discretion. USBC rule 319 shall apply in its entirety. **USBC Sport League Averages will NOT be used or challenge league.**
10. Each individual may bowl with the same teammate more than once but may cash only once with the same teammate. This tournament is certified by the USBC.
11. In submitting of entry, the requested first choice of squad time will be accepted as confirmed, unless the team is notified otherwise.
12. Any individual arriving late for their scheduled squad time will be penalized for any frames missed. There shall be a zero score given for each frame missed with the late bowler's score starting with the frame in which he/she is ready to bowl. No

team shall delay its scheduled start of bowling for the purpose of awaiting a late or absent teammate, or it may be disqualified.

13. This tournament will be governed by all rules and regulations of the USBC. Incidental situations arising shall have determinations made by the Tournament Director.
  14. USBC Rule 319d (all previous winnings over \$600.00 must be reported by both men and women) will apply.
  15. USBC rule 319e is applicable to ALL PARTICIPANTS, and it is their responsibility to be aware of and understand this ruling before bowling the tournament. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of all entry fees and prize money.
  16. Bowlers must submit themselves for re-rating of average after bowling the tournament three times if their submitted average is exceeded by 25 or more pins after their 18 game total, to be able to participate further. Any bowler subjected to re-rating will be advised of such action in advance of his/her next scheduled squad. Any bowler unwilling to accept a re-rated average shall have their entry fee refunded.
  17. USBC prize fund formula applies. In the Team event, a prize ratio of 1 in 6 shall apply. In the Singles event, a prize ratio of 1 in 8 shall apply.
  18. Added money shall be distributed to the guaranteed \$500 for first place in each team division.
  19. Singles entries are optional and open to all entrants. Only bowlers participating in the Doubles event will be allowed to participate in the Singles event.
- Singles Event for the tournament shall be as follows:**
- "A" Division:** 200 & above average; Handicap based upon 90% of the difference between bowler's average and 230.
  - "B" Division:** 199 & below average; Handicap based upon 90% of the difference between bowler's average and 200
  - "Scratch" Division:** Scratch
  - "JR" Division:** 90% of 210 no reverse
20. Singles entry fee is \$10 per bowler. Games 1 through 6 of your Doubles team event will count. Multiple entries will be allowed, but you may cash only once in each division. You must state before bowling that you wish to participate in the Singles event. Prize fund returned 100%. (Prize fund \$8; Expenses \$2 per entry).
  21. Entries will be returned in prizes with USBC approval in the event of war, fire, labor strikes, act of God or any other cause beyond the control of the Tournament Director that makes it impossible or impractical to complete the tournament.
  22. Failure to comply with any of the above rules may result in disqualification and forfeiture of all fees paid.

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
